PROCESS OF APPLICATION:

Step one: Read all the rules and regulations and explain them to the child.

Step two: Fill in the application form.

Step three: Please attach a character reference from his Ustad or the Imaam of the Masjid. If your child has been in another Darul Uloom, attach a character reference letter from the Darul Uloom.

Step four: E-mail the application form to ulama@thejamiat.co.za as well as the birth certificate copy and the character reference to us.

Insha-Allah, we will contact you and arrange an appointment for an interview. Your child should accompany you when you come. A final decision will be forwarded to you within seven days of receiving all documentation.

The Madrasah reserves the right not to forward any reasons for the refusal of any application.

REQUISITES

Your child will require the following:

- Thirteen line Qur'aan Sharief (not colour coded) and Kitaabs
- Pen, pencil, eraser, A4 books and A 5 books.
- Five white kurta sets. The following are absolute stipulations for Kurtas:

Must be 15 cm below knee (not longer) and have slits along each side up to the knee.
No cuffs or collared Kurtaas are allowed.

Please note that all clothing should be labelled with the student's name.

- Two unprinted jerseys for winter. Please note that jerseys, jackets and skippers with writing and logos and emblems on the shoulders etc. are STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- A plate, a bowl, tablespoon, drinking glass
- Scoop, brush, dust cloth, mosquito repellent (*Very important*)
- Lock with 2 keys (*one key to be handed in to the office*)

- Two towels
- Complete bedding and blankets (not mattress)
- Swimming gear that covers the knees
- A Miswaak and a Tasbeeh
- Plain warm winter trousers (must not have stripes)
- Plain rain jacket
- Medication, small and large bandages etc.

Items not allowed:

Tin foods such as tuna, noodles and spaghetti, cooked and fried food, any type of take away foods, electrical appliances such as kettles and electrical blankets. There is no need for students to have any spending money unless they remain on the Madrassah premises during the weekends which the student should leave with the office.

Allowed items:

Home-made biscuits, nuts, 3 packets crisp and 3 chocolates per week are allowed. Kindly bear in mind that cupboard space is limited.
